God has ordained governments to preserve society and believers show reverence and honor to God by submitting to governing authorities.

Submit to authorities established by God. V.1-2.

- Governments everywhere have been established by God.
- Rebelling against authority will bring God's judgment through that gov't

Submit to authorities established by God. V.1-2.

- Commanded to submit:
 - submit means to place oneself under, to choose to be under authority.
 - Jesus submitted to the Romans.

Submit to authorities established by God. V.1-2.

 Believers have a higher authority to which we submit when human authorities require disobedience to the Word of God...

- Fallen humanity needs structure and authority...
- Gov'ts are to commend those who do right and are to punish those who do wrong.

- Gov'ts bear the sword = inflicting punishment for evil/wrongdoing.
- Even to the point of capital punishment.

- Gov'ts are God's servants.
 - The same word translated as Deacon.
 - Gov't workers are accountable to God.
 - To promote good living for people.

- Gov'ts are God's servants.
 - God punishes evil in this world through the use of human gov'ts at all levels.
 - Believers also work to preserve and transform society with the gospel.

Submission involves supporting the government. V.6-7.

- God's servants in government need to be provided for.
 - Pay your taxes. It's God's way of providing for a civil gov't for all people.
 - Honor and respect all gov't officials.

Submission involves supporting the government. V.6-7.

- God's servants in government need to be provided for.
 - Use all legal resources and privileges at our disposal to support and change our gov't.

So, believers are to...

 be model citizens, only disobeying gov't when directed to disobey God's Word.

So, believers are to...

 be involved in our system of governing.

So, believers are to...

 be praying for our government officials.
