Caring for creation is a command that Christians take seriously.

Psalm 24:1 (NIV) The earth is the LORD's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it; 2 for he founded it upon the seas and established it upon the waters.

 Psalm 89:11 (NIV) The heavens are yours, and yours also the earth; you founded the world and all that is in it.

- The earth is valuable, precious, irreplaceable, and sacred.
- We honor God when we honor God's creation.

Psalm 115:16 (NIV) The highest heavens belong to the LORD, but the earth he has given to man.

■ Genesis I:28 (NIV) ...fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air and over every living creature that moves on the ground."

Genesis 2:15 (NIV) The LORD God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it.

- subdue and rule = absolute control.
- humanity is fully in charge on My behalf.

We are the earth's vice regents.

Psalm 19:1 (NIV) The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands. 2 Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they display knowledge.

Romans 1:20 For since the creation of the world God's invisible qualities-his eternal power and divine nature-have been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that men are without excuse.

God intends His creation to announce and communicate who He is and what He is like.

Free to explore but not exploit, enjoy but not worship creation but worship the Creator.

Psalm 8:5 You made him a little lower than the heavenly beings and crowned him with glory and honor. 6 You made him ruler over the works of your hands; you put everything under his feet:

Proverbs I2:I0 (NIV) A righteous man cares for the needs of his animal, but the kindest acts of the wicked are cruel. II He who works his land will have abundant food, but he who chases fantasies lacks judgment.

- God / angels / humans / creation:
- responsibility, stewardship role up to our Creator
- responsibility downward the rest of creation with delicate balance of use and preservation and restoration.

- We need to own our waste, ignorance, and lack of care and concern for the world God entrusted to us.
- We are to be productive but wisely.

GOD COMMANDS ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

- Leviticus 25:2b ... the land itself must observe a sabbath to the LORD.
- Leviticus 25:11 The fiftieth year shall be a jubilee for you; do not sow and do not reap what grows of itself or harvest the untended vines.

GOD COMMANDS ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

Leviticus 25:23 (NIV) "The land must not be sold permanently, because the land is mine and you are but aliens and my tenants.

GOD COMMANDS ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

- God instructed them to take care of the land so that it would continue to fruitfully produce.
- They were to not exploit the land and make it useless for the future.
