May 18, 2020

- As of May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020, these services and ministries are open to public gatherings.
  - Main Worship Service: As of Sunday, May 24<sup>th</sup> at 10am
  - Men's and Women's Groups: Regular schedule but meet only at the church.
- What can we do to **minimize the risk** of spreading the virus?
  - Members and Attenders:
    - Stay home if there is any thought or possibility of any illness or possibility of recent contact with someone who is ill.
    - Practice Social Distancing. Family groups stay 6 ft. apart, no hugs or handshakes if not a part of your household.
    - Reserve the ramp and its entrance for <u>those who must use it</u>.
    - Wait for and allow greeters to open doors into the building and sanctuary.
      - Please try and not go in and out of the building more than once if possible. Try to keep traffic flowing in one direction before and after service.
    - Wear masks if desired.
    - Sit with your family in the same row. Sit in the same row each week.
    - Sit spread out throughout the sanctuary as much as possible. <u>Do not sit in</u> <u>closed off or guest only areas. Extra seating available in the Library area.</u>
    - Place offering in the plates near the main doors as you enter or leave.
    - Wash hands thoroughly after restroom use, eating, coughing, or touching your person.
    - Use sanitizer on your hands often. Don't touch more than you have to.
    - Don't touch your face till you wash/sanitize your hands and then wash/sanitize again after touching your face.
    - Please allow only the pastor and praise team on the platform and near instruments.
      - Praise team please use your own/family instruments.
      - Keep all mics on stands with one microphone.
    - We will not include special music until further notice.
    - <u>Bulletins and message notes will be emailed to you on Friday. Print your</u> <u>own at home or use on your phone or tablet</u>. All songs will be on the screen.
  - Greeters:
    - Please open and close doors into the building for congregation.
      - Greeters open main outer doors for people entering and leaving.
      - Inner doors left open.
    - Wear mask if desired.

## • Offerings:

- Offering plates will be near the east and west main doors so offering can be placed in them <u>without passing the plate</u>. Leave them there to be <u>collected</u> <u>by Financial Secretary/Mike F. only</u>.
  - Prayer for offering will still take place <u>without ushers bringing the</u> <u>offering forward.</u>
- Financial Sec.:
  - Let offerings sit in a closed container for 3-5 days to kill the virus.
  - Use gloves and/or a mask while counting and recording offerings.

## • **Communion**:

- Individual pre-made communion supplies have been purchased.
  - These are prepackaged bread wafers and red grape juice.
  - We will have a Communion Service once those supplies arrive.
  - Small tables with the Communion supplies will be set up near the entry ways for congregation to pick up and use.
  - Trash bins available near the entrances, organ and piano for cups and plates to be thrown away by those who use them.

Cleaning the building:

- Monthly janitors clean after three days or after noon on Wednesday.
  - **Clean with soapy water** all surfaces that are touched by hands. Bleach and other spray detergents may ruin the woodwork.
    - All pew tops, all door handles, all 4 wooden inner doors as far as you can reach, and handrails going to the basement.
    - Bathrooms: all door handles, light switches, sinks, toilets including flush handle.
    - Pastor Andy will clean the pulpit.
    - Mic stands, Music stands, cleaned by Praise Team.
    - Piano cleaned by Nancy or Heather.
    - $\circ$  Jack cleans the organ and Louise cleans the keyboard.
- Potential VBS/CEF 5 Day Clubs:
  - Video lessons utilizing flannel graph or other means?
  - Only with parent permission slips acknowledging their understanding of the risk and willingness for their child to participate.
  - Best social distancing efforts as possible.
  - Kids snacks would need to be pre-purchased, individually wrapped, and able to eat at or on their way home.
